

BADEA's Role in Sustainable Farming

- Facilitate transformation from rainfed agriculture to modernized (Irrigation) agriculture
- Boost agricultural productivities by at least 50%

1.1 The Save Valley Irrigation Project (Mozambique)



1.1 The Save Valley Irrigation Project ,(54q 3(5=2=q)

Objective:

To transform agriculture from subsistence to commercial by modernizing crops production and livestock development.

Components:

- Land leveling of about 1000 ha, construction of drainage canals, and internal earth roads
- Pumps and generators
- PVC pipes for the irrigation networks
- Maintenance equipment and agricultural machineries

1.2 Rice Value Chain Development (Gambia)

1.2 Rice Value Chain Development, (\$10m/\$29.8m)

Objectives:

To increase the income of rice growers nationally by 50% and improve the efficiency of the irrigation systems, enable the access to Agri inputs and technologies, improve the rice value chain, in addition to encourage actors in the private sector to invest in growing rice

Components:

The project comprises:

- Reclaiming 1275 hectares of agricultural lands
- Provision of agricultural machinery, and
- Development of agro-industrial and linking them to markets through construction of feeder roads

1.3 BURA Irrigation and Settlement Scheme Project (Kenya) 1.3 BURA Irrigation and Settlement Scheme Project (\$8m/\$42.4m)

Objectives:

To contribute to the improvement of the welfare of the farmers in the project areas and to help resettle more than 2590 households and commercial farmers.

Components:

The project comprises:

- Construction of gravity intake and canal, including hydraulic structures to allow reliable irrigation of 5460 hectares.
- Rehabilitation and/or Construction of Canal and Farm Roads for a total of 261 km
- Supply of equipment and machines
- micro-credit loans for farmers

1.4 Rural Electrification in 5 Areas (Kenya)



1.4 Rural Electrification in 5 Areas (\$10m/\$63.5m)

Objectives:

To improve the life standard of the rural population by providing reliable electricity to about 591 centers (for marketing and processing of tea and coffee, health centers, educational institutions, and Governmental Centers) and to 35460 households

Components:

The project comprises:

 Construction of 1991 km of 33 kV MV lines and 591 units of 33/0.415 kVA transformers and 709 km of 415 V LV

1.5 Urban Markets and Marketing Development of Agricultural Products (\$10m)

Objectives:

To support, activation and development of agricultural sector through facilitation of marketing of agricultural products for small holders

Components:


The project comprises:

Civil works and ancillaries for the construction of 5 markets with areas 3000-5230 m2. Each market is composed of units for selling meat and fish, kiosks administrative buildings, bathrooms and toilets and facilities for garbage collection, fire fighting facilities

2.1 Agro-Industrial Park, Ethiopia (\$50m/\$114m)

Objective

To facilitate substantial increase in agricultural production in 4 Regions with a total area of 70,000ha and development of SMEs along the agricultural value chain



BADEA's Role in Facilitating Transportation

BADEA ensure that the transport system of a country is well-planned in such a way that:

- Transition from subsistence to smallscale commercial farming can be facilitated
- Huge agricultural potential areas are connected to export markets
- Road infrastructure (that includes feeder roads), storage facilities and transport services are available

BADEA role in **Development of Agri Projects** Financing Feasibility Studies

1. F.S for Agri-processing project in Manica province, Mozambique (\$280 k):

The model for intervention in this study comprises establishment of an Agri Industrial Park (AIP) in an area of 10 hectares.

It is envisaged that the developer (PPP) of the AIP will provide the following services to Manica and neighboring provinces:

- Infrastructure and utilities including master plan, access and internal roads, electricity and water supply and waste management
- Agricultural support services to farmers to improve products quality including extension services to improve farming
 practices, improved seeds quality and mechanization support
- Storage facilities including silos and cold storage to facilitate storage of surpluses for farmers and traders for subsequent marketing
- Quality control and certification services
- Commodity exchange unit and marketing facilitation platform
- Administrative unit for the overall management of the Agro-processing Park
- The Developer will also provide land plots to be utilized for processing units to be rented for investors
