

Restitution workshop of the report on expanding Arab-African Trade and Investment potential <u>29 November 2024, Casablanca - Morocco</u>



Within the framework of enhancing trade and investment opportunities between Arab and African nations, the Islamic Centre for Development of Trade (ICDT) and the BADEA - Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa conducted a study to evaluate the potential for trade between these regions amid the current challenging international landscape. This analysis



underscores opportunities for mutual growth and pinpoints critical sectors for bilateral economic cooperation.

To present the study's recommendations, Ministry of trade and industry of the kingdom of Morocco, the ICDT and BADEA hosted a workshop on October 29 and 30, 2024, in Casablanca, Morocco.

The restitution workshop aimed to present and validate the key findings of the report on expanding trade and investment potential between Arab and African countries.

It facilitated in-depth discussions on the proposed recommendations and engaged representatives from both regions to identify collaboration opportunities and strategies to overcome existing challenges, enhance mutual understanding and strengthen economic ties.
